Dear Sir,

We would like to draw your kind attention towards sudden stoppage of transactions by Kandla Port Trust related to transfer, mortgage, mutation of plots / properties of Sindhu Resettlement Corporation [SRC] Ltd. in Gandhidham - Adipur area.

As reports reaching to us, the said process is stopped by Kandla Port Trust based on the instruction received from Shipping Ministry, New Delhi. As we further understand the Shipping Ministry has passed the direction due to some issue regarding SRC Ltd.

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Whilst on the subject, these areas are developed as mercy project after independence of India mainly for migrant from Sindh. By this time 25000 – 30000 lease of SRC Ltd. are on record wherein 90% of them belong to poor, middle class, service class and small traders.

Since the said process got stopped, the whole economy of the town has been badly affected and the poor people of the town are unable to fulfil their obligation towards child education, marriages etc. for which they may opt to sell the property to fulfil these obligations. The Gandhidham Chamber of Commerce & Industry strongly feels that the people of this town are under ban and chaos is prevailing due to the stoppage of transaction of land and property. This results into violation of fundamental rights of the people.

Therefore, we earnestly request you to please direct Kandla Port Trust to start process of transfer, mortgage, mutation related to SRC Ltd's plots / properties immediately.

Hope, the matter will be immediately, earnestly considered favourably for the interest of general public at large.
