SUPPLEMENTARY BUDGET PROPOSAL FOR THE FORTHCOMING REVENUE BUDGET 2018-19

1) SEZs of India

- a) SEZ units and developers should be exempted from MAT by scrapping in forthcoming revenue budget as MAT had a huge negative impact on exports from SEZ.
- b) To revamp framework for SEZs to spur private investments in light of switchover to GST and to boost "Make in India".
- c) To slash the category of deemed exports.
- d) To reduce minimum area requirement for smaller and special category states.
- e) To make the entry, exit ad operations within SEZ easier and incentivizing exports by simplifying the procedure.
- f) To remove operational restrictions such as manufacturing for domestic units.
- g) To make arrangements to access cheap finance for SEZ units and developer.
- h) To offer incentives for setting up overseas banking units in SEZs.
- GST should be completely exempted for SEZ units and developer to get relief from procedural aspects in place of the present zero rated status.

In all, above suggestions and proposals are need of the hour to boost "Make in India", to drive jobs and growth & for the complete makeover of India's SEZ.

2) Goods & Service Tax

- a) More GST rates should be rationalised in consultation with the Trade Bodies.
- b) Lesser rate for uan-power supply services.
- c) Govt. & GST Council to fix the anomaly and bring parity oin GST rates charged on contractor and sub-contractors or provide a mechanism to make good their losses.
- d) Supply of blood from Blood Bank should be totally exempted from GST.
- e) Acute needs to review the entire system of food processing from GST point of view starting from post-harvest to the arrival of packaged food to the retail stores. Different rates for food processing industry fixed in the GST regime resulting higher product prices.

- f) Similar GST rate for both restaurant and caterers.
- g) Refund should be allotted to the exporter for GST paid on capital goods rather than only credit of GST.
- h) Petroleum products and real estate should be brought under the scope of GST.
- i) NO GST on sale of old vehicle for transporter opting 5% RCM scheme and no GST on sale of old car for all assesse.

3) Budgetary provisions for recent announcement projects

There should be proper provision in budgetary allocation for the recent announcements of the establishment of cruise terminal of international standard at Kandla Port and direct connectivity of Kandla – Maliya by road & rail.

4) Railway Operation

- a) Budgetary allocation for the pending & on-going projects of electrification to speed-up completion of such projects.
- b) To prioritize and revamp safety in railway operation, there should increase in budgetary allocation for the upgradation and implementation of railway operation to meet the ultimate objective of higher safety norms.
- c) To incorporate new trains from Kutch region as proposed below:
 - i. Suggest to start new trains from Kachchh to North India connecting UP, Punjab & Delhi. Similarly connectivity to Kerala and Tamil Nadu should be established by starting new trains.
 - ii. The frequency of Kamakhya Train should be twice in a week from present frequency on once in week.
 - iii. Introduction of Inter City Train from Gandhidham to Vadodara / Surat.
 - iv. Jodhpur Train should be run daily.
 - v. The present running of trains from Gandhidham to Palanpur should be reschedule for connection to Rajdhanai and Ashram Express.
 - vi. At present A.C. Train to Mumbai runs thrice in a week which needs to be run daily.
