Sub: Frequent problem of the disruption in work due to non-availability of internet services at RTO – Gandhidham in Kachchh District

As you aware we, The Gandhidham Chamber of Commerce & Industry is a pioneer organisation of Kandla – Gandhidham complex since 1953 with the main objective of serving as a bridge between local trade and industry fraternity and State / Central Govt. for the resolution of problems on regular basis.

We would like to draw your kind attention towards frequent disruption of internet service at R.T.O. – Gandhidham – Kachchh resulting to the stoppage of R.T.O. work.

Sir, we would like to appraise you that transport industry is very well developed in this complex mainly due to EXIM operation at nearby port of Kandla and Mundra. Hence, transport industry is a life – line of the district of Kachchh. This Kachchh district being the biggest district of India in terms of area, two separate RTO are functional in this district. RTO – Gandhidham covers its jurisdiction to the span of 100 ·125 kms. away located towns and villages like Khadir & Adesar. Hence, when people approaches RTO – Gandhidham for their work after travelling a long distance and if work is not completed due to non- availability of internet services mainly due to connectivity problem causes unbearable hardship to the people. Moreover, when govt. encourages cashless payment through digital services and existing digital service itself is not serving any meaningful purpose to the people then big question mark arises in the mind of people for the future of cashless transactions.

Therefore, we request you to use your good offices to resolve this problem permanently for the ultimate benefit of the stakeholders.
